Kelemen Quartet
with 2002 Gold Medalist Barnabás Kelemen**



2002 IVCI Gold Medalist Barnabás Kelemen and the Kelemen Quartet will perform on the Laureate Series on Tuesday, October 20 at 7:30 p.m. at Indiana Landmarks Center, 1201 Central Avenue. Founded in Budapest in 2010, the Quartet has rapidly gained a reputation as one of the most exciting young string quartets. The *Dallas News* declared it as "the most electrifying string quartet concerts in recent memory" and applauded the ensemble's "highly inflected and vividly interactive music-making."

Each of the quartet's members--violinist Barnabás Kelemen, violinist/violist Katalin Kokas, violinist/violist Gábor

Homoky, and cellist László Fenyő--are prize-winning musicians and are known for both their chamber and solo work. The program will include Haydn's String Quartet No. 2 in D minor, Op. 76, "Fifths"; Kurtág's Six Moments Musicaux, Op. 44; and Bartók's String Quartet No. 5, Sz. 102.
