## Upcoming Concerts Feature 2014 Bronze and Silver Medalists



2014 Bronze Medalist Ji Young Lim and pianist Chih-Yi Chen will present the final concert of the 2015-16 IVCI Laureate Series on Tuesday, May 10 at 7:30 p.m. at the Indiana History Center, 450 W. Ohio Street, Indianapolis. After winning the Bronze Medal at the Ninth Quadrennial Competition, Ji Young went on to win the Queen Elisabeth Violin Competition in Belgium in 2015. She has performed as soloist with orchestras in the United States, Germany, Japan, Korea, Switzerland, Belgium and Canada. She recently performed a critically acclaimed recital at The Phillips Collection in Washington, D.C.

This recital features Schubert's Rondo for Violin and Piano in B minor; Grieg's Sonata for Violin and Piano in C minor; Brahms' Sonata for Violin and Piano No. 3 in D minor; and Hubay's Carmen Fantasie Brillante for Violin and Piano.
