## 2014 Laureate Dami Kim Closes Out IVCI's 2017-2018 Season May 15

INDIANAPOLIS – The International Violin Competition of Indianapolis (IVCI) will present its final Laureate Series concert of the 2017-2018 Season, featuring 2014 Laureate **Dami Kim** and pianist Chih-Yi Chen in recital on Tuesday, May 15 at 7:30 PM at the Eugene and Marilyn Glick Indiana History Center, 450 West Ohio Street, Indianapolis.

**Dami Kim** is one of six Laureates from the 9<sup>th</sup> Quadrennial IVCI Competition in 2014 who also garnered special prizes at that Competition for “Best Performance of a Beethoven Sonata” (Sonata No. 3 in E-flat, Op. 12) and “Best Performance of a Classical Finals Concerto” (Mozart Concerto No. 5 in A major, K. 219). A 2012 graduate of the New England Conservatory in Boston, she is also a laureate of the International Queen Elisabeth Competition in Brussels, Belgium and the first prize winner of the Joseph Joachim International Violin Competition in Hannover, Germany. She is currently pursuing a Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Performance at Stony Brook University in New York, studying with Philip Setzer and Jennifer Frautschi. She performs on a 1731 Stradivarius on loan from the Yellow Angel Foundation in Japan.

The program will consist of Schumann’s *Fantasiestücke*, Op.73 and the Sonata No. 1 in A minor, Op. 105, John Corigliano’s *The Red Violin Caprices*, and Frolov’s *Concert Fantasy on Themes from Gershwin’s Porgy and Bess*, Op. 19. She will be joined by Indiana University Jacobs School of Music faculty member and IVCI official pianist Chih-Yi Chen.
