IVCI Postpones Time for Three and Dreamers' Circus Performances

Travel-related pandemic recommendations affect 20/21 Laureate Series

INDIANAPOLIS – Due to recent recommendations from the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention regarding domestic and international travel as well as current Marion County Health Department quarantine guidelines, the IVCI is postponing its upcoming performances of **Time for Three** (January 26) and **Dreamers' Circus** (April 8).

The Nordic trio Dreamers' Circus, originally scheduled for April 8 this year, will be moved to February 2022 as part of the 2021/2022 Laureate Series.

Time for Three has been rescheduled for April 8, 2021. All tickets will remain valid for this new date, and patrons wishing to exchange should contact the IVCI office.

The IVCI regards the health and safety of its patrons, staff and musicians as the highest priority. Currently, no other 20/21 Laureate Series concerts have been affected.
