## 2006 Gold Medalist Augustin Hadelich embarks on four-city tour across New Zealand in late August

2006 Gold Medalist **Augustin Hadelich** will perform later this month with the <u>New Zealand Symphony Orchestra</u> in four cities across the North Island with conductor Dima Slobodeniouk. His first performance with the NZSO in 2018 "had some members of the audience in tears," according to the Waikato Times.

Hadelich will perform the Tchaikovsky Violin Concerto in Wellington (Aug 23), Rotorua (Aug 27), Auckland (Aug 29) and Hamilton (Aug 30).

Augustin will be back in Indianapolis as part of the <u>IVCI</u> <u>Laureate Series</u> on Friday, November 22 to perform works by Poulenc, David Lang, Ysaÿe, Beach, Perkinson and Ravel. Several of these works are featured on Augustin's upcoming recording "<u>American Road Trip</u>," which releases later this month.
